I can confirm that Northern, Eastern and Western Devon CCG hold the requested information.

I am researching the local indicators for CCG Quality Premiums that Northern, Eastern And Western Devon CCG are now undertaking. Can you please send me a copy of these local priorities?

CCG Quality Premiums are described in Quality Premium: 2013/14 Guidance for CCGs (1st May 2013, NHS England. Publications Gateway Reference: 00002).

The three local priorities that we have selected as our Quality Premium measures for 2013/14 are:

- a) People with diabetes who have received the nine care processes
- b) People completing treatment with a 5 point improvement in either GAD7 or PHQ9 scores (local indicator of IAPT recovery rates)
- c) Admittance of patients to a stroke unit within 4-hours
