## Primary care, community and other health services

Healthcare services include primary care services (such as GP surgeries, opticians and pharmacies), community services (such as district nursing and mental health), and a range of other key services. Holsworthy also has a community hospital.

## Care in people's homes

A team of 37 health and social care staff, in Holsworthy and the surrounding areas, work to rehabilitate patients, avoid admissions and promote health, wellbeing and independence

The average time staff spend with patients is 32 minutes (NDHT statistical analysis: May 2017 – March 2018)

Holsworthy Community Hospital is one of five community hospitals in Northern Devon.
